Anglican – English

331 Fifth Avenue, Timmins

Mr. P.A. Robbins, manager of the Hollinger Mine, built the church in 1913, resulting in the first Anglican service in the new building on November 13th of that year.

4. If you would like to see the church interior, please call 24 hours ahead and make an appointment - please make sure to call and cancel if you change your mind.
5. Watch for people in the churchyard - they'll often be happy to show you around.
