TIMMINS CHAMBER OF COMMERCE RELEASES BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION RESULTS

TIMMINS: The Timmins Chamber of Commerce is pleased to announce the voting results for its 2007-08 Board of Directors election. Voting was conducted by mail-in ballot between mid-June and July 13. A total of 303 ballots were received representing 32.4% of eligible voting members casting their ballots.

A total of eight new members have been elected to the 21-person volunteer Board. They will be sworn in at the Chamber of Commerce Annual General Meeting, to be held Sept. 13 at the Days Inn.

"I am pleased that so many members have exercised their voting rights in our Board election," said 2007-08 incoming Chamber President Marilyn Wood. "The eight new members of our Board bring experience, business acumen, and the passion to make Timmins a better place to conduct business for our members. All candidates should be commended for seeking election - it certainly reflects their desire to take a leadership position in the business community."
