TIMMINS DAILY PRESS BUILDING PEWTER ORNAMENT NOW ON SALE

TIMMINS: As part of its ongoing effort to celebrate local heritage, the Timmins Chamber of Commerce Tourism Committee is pleased to announce that the Timmins Daily Press Building pewter ornament is now available for sale.

The Timmins Daily Press ornament is the sixth in the Chamber of Commerce Pewter Ornament Series. It measures four inches in diameter and comes with its own attractive gift box. It can be purchased at the Chamber of Commerce Tourist Information Centre, the Shania Twain Centre and the Timmins Museum. The cost for the Daily Press Building pewter ornament is \$10.95 plus tax.

"The Chamber of Commerce Tourism Committee believes it is important to recognize local landmarks that helped shape our community," said Tourism Committee Co-chair Bruce Cowan. "The Timmins Daily Press Building was a fixture for several decades at the corner of Cedar Street and Second Avenue. The Tourism Committee is thrilled that its likeness will live on as part of the Pewter Ornament Series."

Before its demolition, The Timmins Daily Press Building was one of the area's most significant landmarks. The Timmins Daily Press was the first newspaper owned by Roy Thomson, who would go on to own over 200 newspapers, including the Times of London.
